11 DAYS / 10 NIGHTS ALL IN!

Day 01 : MNL - AMMAN - MT. NEBO - MADABA

Upon arrival in Amman airport, proceed to meet our arrival transfer assistant. Commence tour as we drive to Madaba, land of fruits and water where you can see the first Holy Land Map. Continue to Mt. Nebo, believed to be the burial site of Moses, Proceed to your hotel for check in. Dinner and Overnight at hotel in Amman.

Day 02 : AMMAN - PETRA - AMMAN.

Today's activity is a visit the fabled "Red Rose City" of Petra, the 2000 year old Nabatean capital, now one of the World's wonders. Take a horse ride to the Siq. Then walk to the Treasury, a rose colored monumental building artfully carved out of sheer rock. Visit the other temples and tombs carved into the mountainside. Return to your hotel for Dinner and Overnight.

Day 03 : AMMAN-ALLENBY-BORDER-QUMRAN-DEAD SEA - GALILEE.

Brace yourself today as we journey to Allenby border (this is the border of Israel and Jordan). Bundle up with loads of patience as the queue in the border will take a while. After immigration, WELCOME TO ISRAEL - The promise Land. Drive to Jericho, the city that Joshua destroyed AND THE OLDEST CITY IN THE WORLD to see the Sycamore Tree and Mount Temptation. After Lunch, continue to Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Then on to the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth. Experience floating on its mineral rich waters. Dinner and overnight at your hotel

Day 04 : CANA - NAZARETH - CAPERNAUM - TABGHA - ST. PETER'S PRIMACY - MT. OF BEATITUDES - JORDAN RIVER.

After breakfast, move on to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle, He turned the water into wine at the Wedding in Cana. Move on to Nazareth, visit the Church of the Annunciation where the Archangel Gabriel announced to Virgin Mary the birth of Jesus Christ. Visit also St. Joseph's workshop and Mary's well. Proceed to Capernaum where Jesus mostly taught and on to Tabgha. Visit St. Peter's Primacy Church. Visit Mt. of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount took place. Proceed to Yardenit, where traditionally, Jesus was baptized. Dinner & overnight in Tiberias

Day 05 : MT. TABOR - MT. CARMEL - CEASAREA - JAFFA - JERUSALEM.

Drive to Mt. Tabor early in the morning to visit the site of Transfiguration. You shall visit Haifa, to Stella Maris where one can enjoy a panoramic view of the Mediterranean. Drive down to Caesarea, which was built by Herod the Great to catch sight of the Aqueducts and the Roman Theater. This is where St. Paul was imprisoned. Proceed to Jaffa and visit the city where Yona set sail on. Also, visit the House of Simon the Tanner. Move on to Jerusalem to visit the Western Wall or the Wailing Wall. Dinner & overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 06 : EIN KAREM - BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM NEW CITY

After breakfast Proceed to Ein Kerem to visit the Church of St. John & the Church of Visitation. In the afternoon, continue the journey to Bethlehem to visit the Church of Nativity where Jesus was born. Then proceed to the Shepherds' Field where the star appeared to the shepherds which lead them to the manger where baby Jesus was born proceed to Mount Scopus where you can have a sightseeing of the Old and New City of Jerusalem. Move on to the Mount of Olives to visit the Ascension Chapel

where Jesus ascended into Heaven. Visit the Church of Pater Noster to witness the "Lord's Prayer" written in several languages. Proceed to the church of Dominus Flevit (God Wept) where God wept over Jerusalem. You shall walk down the Palm Sunday road to the Church of All Nations & the Garden of Gethsemane where you can see the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed before the Roman soldiers came for Him. Back to hotel for dinner & overnight.

Day 07 : JERUSALEM OLD CITY

After breakfast, visit the Church of St. Anne, Pool of Bethesda. Today we enter the Old City of Jerusalem through Herod's Gate. Walk the Via Dolorosa starting at the Ecce Homo where Pontius Pilate washed his to eternal sleep hands. Proceed to the Flagellation and through all the Stations and reach the Church of the Holy Sepulchre where Jesus was crucified, died and rose from the dead. We visit the Mount Zion area where we see the Upper Room where Jesus and His disciples have their last supper. The Church of Dormition, where Mary went and the Church of St. Peter in Galllicantu, the House of the High Priest Caiaphas where St. Peter denied Jesus three times. Back to the hotel in Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

Day 08 : ELAT-TABA BORDER-ST. CATHERINE. Another long day awaits us today, We check out then drive to Eilat the winter resort of Israel. We cross Taba Border (the border of Israel and Egypt).

On arrival in Israel side of border, disembark and pass immigration. After passing through Immigration formalities, walk to Egypt side where our representative welcome the groups. Drive to St. Catherine for hotel check in. Dinner and Overnight.

Day 09 : MT. SINAI - SHARM EL SHEIKH.

OPTIONAL : Around 12midnight for Mountain Climbing on Mt. Sinai where Moses received the Ten Commandments. And for the rest of the pilgrims, who are not apt to this activity, enjoy the rest of the night until wake up time for breakfast. At 080 hours (timing may change), all pilgrims now check out of the hotel Commence your tour to visit the St. catherine Monastery (if open) Visit the "burning bush" and Jethro's well. Proceed to Sharm el Sheikh famous in the world for its exquisite Naama Bay. Indulge in once in a lifetime optional activities such as Safari Desert. Marvel at the amazing 5,000 years old corals of the Red Sea aboard the glass boat or simply relax in the beach. Drive to Cairo for hotel check in and Overnight

Day 10 : CAIRO -

Start the day at the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, housing the gold treasures of Tutankhamen. See a wonder of the ancient world. The Pyramids of Giza and the nearby Sphinx. Dinner Cruise and show on the Nile River. Return to your hotel for Overnight.

Day 11 : CAIRO - DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel then continue to Hanging Church dating to the 4th and early 5th Century. This Basilica was built on the top of the south gate of the Fortress of Babylon. Then Visit Church of Abu Sergah, built on the cave in which the Holy Family stayed and is regarded by visitors as a source of blessing. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight back to Manila on March 29 0045AM.
